Most importantly, the food is more than decent. I had the black miso cod, which was slightly charred yet melt-in-your-mouth smooth - just the way I like it. The mashed sweet potato was interesting, but I've never liked that particular vegetable.

The wife had grilled chicken with truffle sauce. The chicken was nicely grilled and the sauce was flavourful without being overpowering.

The only disappointing dish was the calamari we shared. The batter was strangely powdery; perhaps the oil was not hot enough? The meat was also too chewy.

Anyhow, set meal offers ensured we got free dessert, drink and soup. The vanilla-choc ice-cream reminded me of Ben & Jerry's Rocky Road, and the soup was delightfully swimming with munchy mushroom bits.
